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# WHAT IS BEDROCK LEARNING?



Bedrock Learning is an online programme that teaches students Tier 2 Vocabulary. These are words that they encounter in every day life that they need to be able to communicate and to be able to access the exams.

They will be doing twenty minutes of Bedrock as part of their Functional Skills course and they will be set around half an hour of Bedrock Learning homework every week.

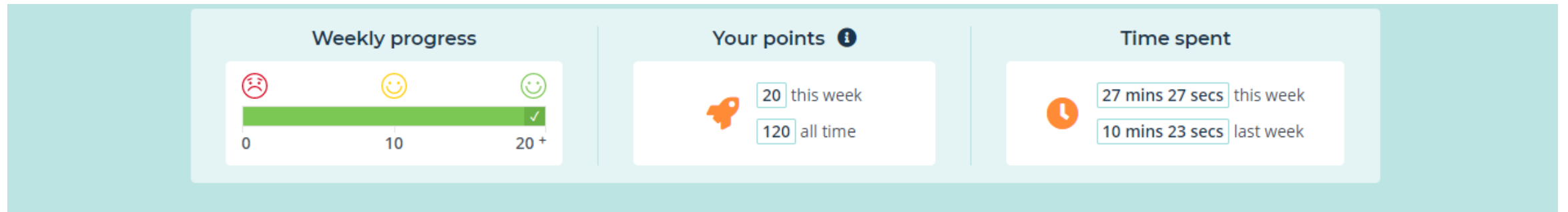

At the top of their dashboard, students are able to see how many lessons they have completed this week, how many points they have accumulated and how much time they have spent on Bedrock.

There is also a handy knowledge organiser of words they are learning, already know and have already learned to ensure that students keep recalling the same vocabulary.

Teachers can see all of the reports on the right hand side, including who has the most points across the year group, what words students are consistently getting wrong and how long they are spending on Bedrock a week.



# WHAT DOES BEDROCK LOOK LIKE FOR TEACHERS?

Teachers can see all quiz results, what block has been allocated and how many lessons students have completed a week. We can also see any word trends so that these are incorporated into our teaching.
