Dear Parents/Carers and Students

Re: Transition work 2021-2022 (Year 12)

First of all, thank you for your application and for choosing the Energy Coast UTC Sixth Form for the next phase of your educational pathway. We are very much looking forward to welcoming all students in the next academic year and supporting you with your chosen courses of study.

The last 18 months of education has been very difficult and disrupted for lots of students as a direct result of the global pandemic and consequent changes to course content, examinations and ultimately student attendance in the classroom.
